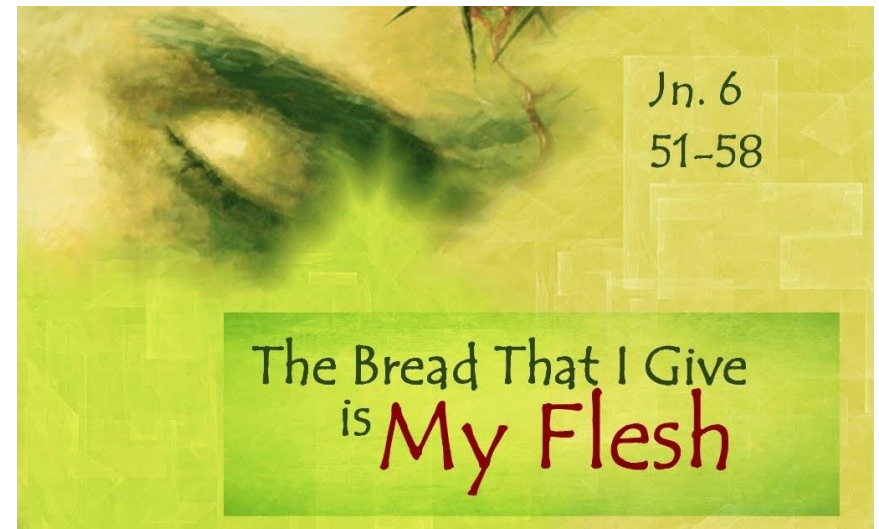

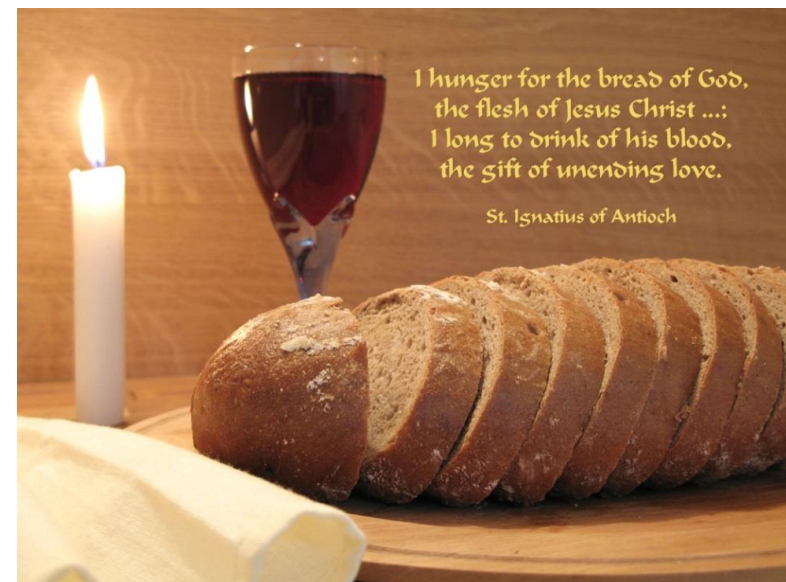

Wednesday noon Eucharists continue all summer long. It's a great chance to worship and stay connected to our parish even if you are away on the weekend!

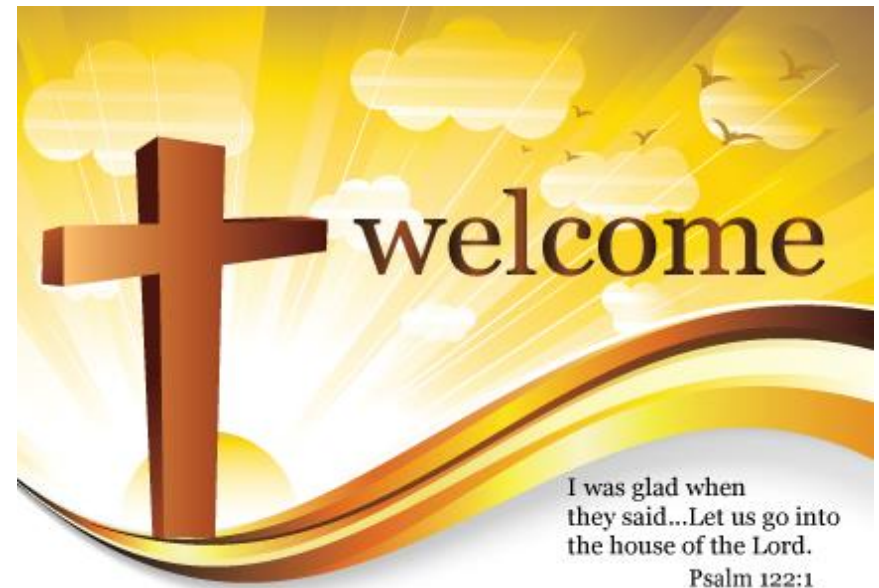
