

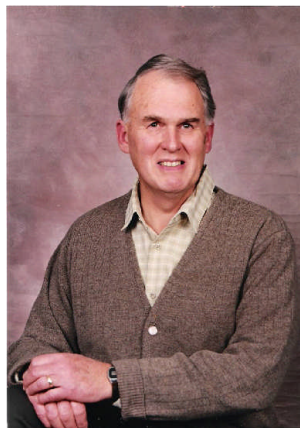
What It Is

This is a local outreach fund aimed at providing financial assistance to individuals who are economically challenged so that they may improve their chances of increasing their income. Some examples include: an upgrade in education, a new skill, obtaining a tool for a trade or a licence.



Who May Apply

The fund is open to all who are in need and are motivated to improve their skills and income. Parishioners of St. John's and their families (children, siblings and parents) are ineligible.

Bill Rawlinson

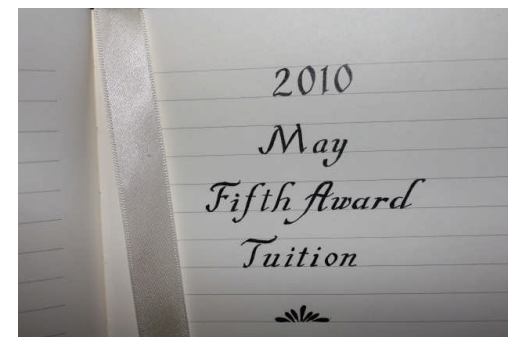

How to Apply

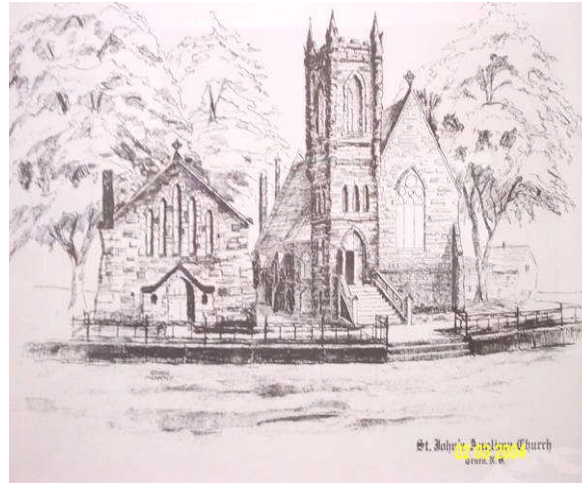
Anyone may suggest a candidate or an individual may submit their own name for consideration. Applications are available at the church office and on the Parish website.



Making a Donation

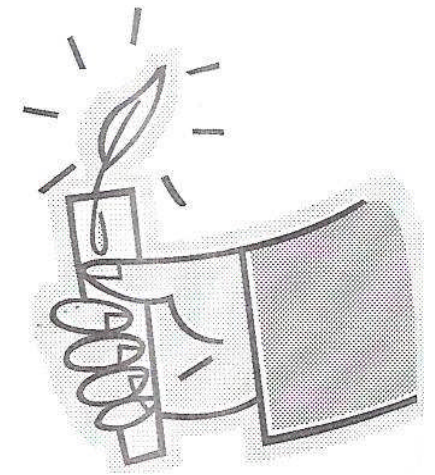
