Welcome / Historical Tidbit

Opening Music: Joyful, Joyful, We Adore Thee

Leader: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

Leader: Merciful God, grant to your faithful people, pardon and peace, that we may be cleansed from all our sins and serve you with a quiet mind, through Jesus Christ our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God now and for ever. **Amen**

Leader: The peace of the Lord be always with you.

People: And also with you.
